
ENGINE OIL

Engine Oil Level Check

Check engine oil level each day before operating the ATC.

The oil filler cap (1) is on the right crankcase cover and contains a dipstick for measuring the oil level. The oil level must be maintained between the upper (2) and lower (3) level marks on the dipstick. To check the oil level:

1. Unlatch and raise the seat for better access to the oil filler cap.



- (1) Oil filler cap/dipstick (3) Lower level mark
- (2) Upper level mark

- 2. With the ATC on level ground, remove the oil filler cap/dipstick and wipe it clean.
- Reinsert the dipstick without screwing it in. Remove the oil filler cap/dipstick again and check the oil level.
- 4. If required add the specified oil up to the upper level mark. Do not overfill.
- 5. Replace the filler cap/dipstick.

CAUTION:

* Running the engine with insufficient oil can cause serious engine damage.
