CLEANING

Clean your motorcycle regularly to protect the surface finishes and inspect for damage, wear, and oil or brake fluid leakage. CAUTION:

* High pressure water (or air) can damage certain parts of the motorcycle.

Avoid spraying high pressure water (typical in coin-operated car washes) at the following areas:

Wheel Hubs Ignition Switch Carburetor Brake Master Cylinder Instruments Handlebar Switches Muffler Outlet Under Fuel Tank Drive Chain Under Seat Headlight 1. After cleaning, rinse the motorcycle thoroughly with plenty of clean water. Strong detergent residue can corrode alloy parts.

NOTE:

* Clean the headlight lens, meter lens and other plastic parts using a cloth or sponge dampened with a solution of mild detergent and water. Rub the soiled area gently rinsing it frequently with fresh water.
