- 12. Make sure the plug washer is in good condition.
- 13. With the plug washer attached, thread the spark plug in by hand to prevent cross-threading.
- 14. Tighten each spark plug:
 - If the old plug is good: 1/8 turn after it seats.
 - If installing a new plug, tighten it twice to prevent loosening:
 - a) First, tighten the plug:
 - NGK: 1/2 turn after it seats. DENSO: 1 turn after it seats.
 - b) Then loosen the plug.
 - c) Next, tighten the plug again: 1/8 turn after it seats.

NOTICE

Improperly tightened spark plug can damage the engine. If a plug is too loose, a piston may be damaged. If a plug is too tight, the threads may be damaged.

- 15. Reinstall the ignition coils.
- 16. Connect the ignition coil connectors to the ignition coils as before removal.
- 17. Install the remaining parts in the reverse order of removal.
