
Spark Plug

- 2. Disconnect the spark plug cap (1). Take care to avoid damaging the spark plug wire when disconnecting the cap.
- 3. Clean any dirt from around the spark plug base. Using a spark plug wrench, remove the spark plug.
- 4. Discard the spark plug.
- 5. Check the spark plug gap (2), using a wire-type feeler gauge. If adjustment is necessary, bend the side electrode (3) carefully.

The gap should be:

0.031 - 0.035 in (0.80 - 0.90 mm)



- (2) spark plug gap (3) side electrode
- 6. With the plug washer attached, thread the spark plug in by hand to prevent cross-threading.
