ACC TERMINAL

The ACC terminal is in the fuse box (page 166). The terminal and optional socket provide 12 V DC power for electrical accessories. When both terminal and socket are being used, the combined power rating of each accessory should be 60 watts (5 amps) or less. If equipped with accessories, check the battery frequently to determine the state of charge and examine it for possible sulfation. Higher current demands may blow the fuse or discharge the battery. Review the Accessories and Modifications (page 6) before installing accessories. Connect accessory electrical leads securely, and keep them insulated, away from hot parts and sharp edges.

Do not exceed 5 amps for prolonged current demands.
