
Starting Procedure (after Preparation)

To restart a warm engine, follow the procedure for High Air Temperature.

Normal Air Temperature

$$10^{\circ} - 35^{\circ} \text{C} (50^{\circ} - 95^{\circ} \text{F})$$

- 1. Move the choke lever (4) while pushing it all the way to "Fully Open (A)".
- 2. Turn the ignition switch (5) to ON. Make sure that the transmission is in the neutral by checking the neutral indicator lamp (6).
- 3. Press the starter button (7) and start the engine.




(4) Choke lever

NOTE:

- * Do not use the electric starter for more than 5 seconds at a time. Release the starter button for approximately 10 seconds before pressing it again.
- * The starter motor will operate only when the transmission is in neutral.
- 4. Immediately after the engine starts, release the starter button.
- 5. About a half minute after the engine starts, move the choke lever while pushing it all the way to "Fully Closed (B)".
- 6. If idling is unstable, open the throttle slightly.
