Choke Cable and Lever




Fig. 4-8 (1) Choke cable (2) Choke lever

Check the condition of the choke cable (Fig. 4-8) and the operation of the choke lever (2). If the cable is damaged or kinked, have it replaced by your Honda dealer.

Adjusting Idle Speed and Air-Fuel Mixture

NOTE:

Do not try to compensate for faults in other systems by adjusting the carburetor.

To adjust the idle speed:

- 1. Warm up the engine. The engine must be warm for accurate idle adjustment. Ten minutes of stop-and-go riding is sufficient.
- Adjust idle speed and turning the throttle stop screw (Fig. 4-9). Idle Speed:

 $1,400 \pm 100 \, \mathrm{min^{-1}}$
