## Flooded Engine

If the engine does not start after several attempts, it may have become flooded with excess fuel. To clear the engine:

- 1. Turn the engine stop switch OFF ( M ).
- 2. Move the choke lever to the OFF position.
- Hold the throttle fully open and briefly press the starter button or operate the recoil starter several times.
- 4. When the engine is cleared, wait 10 seconds. Then turn the engine stop switch to RUN ( $\Omega$ ) and repeat the normal starting procedure, but don't use the choke.

## **Low Battery**

If the battery is low or dead, use the recoil starter (page 19) to start the engine.

## **High Altitude Adjustment**

For operation above 3,000 feet (1,000 m), it may be necessary to switch to high altitude carburetor jetting (see page100).
