Starting & Stopping the Engine

Flooded Engine

If the engine fails to start after repeated attempts, it may be flooded with excess fuel. To clear a flooded engine:

(TRX450ER)

- 1. Move the engine stop switch to OFF (\(\)).
- 2. Push the choke knob right all the way to fully OFF.
- 3. Open the throttle fully.
- 4. Press the start button for 5 seconds.
- 5. Wait 10 seconds, then turn the engine stop switch to RUN ().
- 6. Repeat the "Normal Air Temperature" starting procedure, but don't use the choke.

(TRX450R)

- 1. Push the choke knob right all the way to fully OFF.
- 2. With the throttle fully opened, repeat kickstarter operation approximately 10 times very slowly to discharge excessive fuel from the engine.
- 3. Push the hot start lever and kick-start the engine. (Do not open the throttle.)
- 4. As soon as the engine starts, release the hot start lever.
