## **Engine Stop Switch**

The engine stop switch (Fig. 2-6 ) is next to the left handgrip, and it has three positions. When the switch is in the RUN ( $\Omega$ ) position, the engine will operate. When the switch is in either OFF ( $\aleph$ ) position, the engine will not operate.

This switch is intended primarily as a safety or emergency control, and it should normally remain in the RUN ( $\Omega$ ) position.

## NOTE:

If you stop your FOURTRAX by turning the engine stop switch OFF ( $\boxtimes$ ), be sure to turn the ignition switch OFF ( $\bigcirc$ ) to prevent battery discharge.


