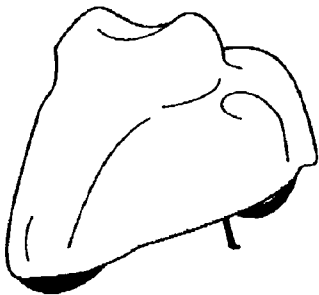


Caring for your motorcycle

Please keep your vehicle in a safe place and use a cover when kept outside. Any cover used should be an open weave fabric that can breathe. The use of nylon or "sealed" materials will cause the machine to "sweat" and will result in surface corrosion.

Tip:

Always apply a cover well after the engine and the muffler have Cooled down, to avoid condensation build up and fire danger.



If you are not going to ride your motorcycle for a while, please:

- apply wax to prevent rust, and
- remove and store the battery in well ventilated area. Alternatively, you can disconnect the negative terminal of the battery and leave it mounted in the motorcycle.
- NOTE: Leaving the battery uncharged for any length of time, whether disconnected or not, will result in the battery discharging and may cause the battery to fail.
- When taking you machine out of storage, it may be necessary to drain old fuel from the carburettor bowl, to enable you to start the machine.
