TROUBLESHOOTING

Engine cranks but won't start.

- 1. No fuel in tank.
- 2. No fuel to cylinder.
- 3. Too much fuel getting to cylinder.
- 4. No spark at plug (ignition malfunction).
- 5. Air cleaner clogged.

Engine idles roughly, stalls, or runs poorly

- 1. Idle speed incorrect.
- 2. Ignition malfunction.
- 3. Rich mixture.
- 4. Lean mixture.
- 5. Air cleaner dirty.
- 6. Insulator leaks.

Lean mixture

- 1. Carburetor fuel jet clogged.
- 2. Fuel cap vent blocked.
- 3. Fuel filter clogged.
- 4. Fuel line kinked or restricted.
- 5. Float valve faulty.
- 6. Float level too low.

Rich mixture

- 1. Carburetor choke stuck closed.
- 2. Float valve faulty.
- 3. Float level too high.
- 4. Carburetor air jet clogged.
- 5. Air cleaner dirty.
