- **13.** Raise the front wheel off the ground again, and check that the wheel rotates freely after you release the brake.
- **14.** Remove the protective tape or cloth.

If a torque wrench was not used for installation, see your dealer as soon as possible to verify proper assembly. Improper assembly may lead to loss of braking capacity.

# Rear Wheel

#### Removal

1. Support your vehicle securely and raise the rear wheel off the ground using a maintenance stand or a hoist.

## **2.** CRF1100D/D4

Release the parking brake. 2 P. 125

### **3.** CRF1100A/A4

Cover both sides of the rear wheel, spoke and brake caliper with protective tape or cloth.

#### CRF1100D/D4

Cover both sides of the rear wheel, spoke and rear brake and parking brake calipers with protective tape or cloth.
