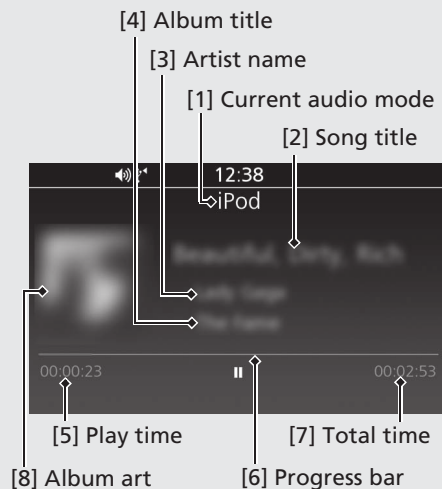


Audio System (Continued)

Playing Audio

The audio system can play music stored on a device connected via USB or *Bluetooth*®.



Screen Information

The information displayed on the screen differs depending on the connected device and the type of file being played back.

The system supports ID3 tag information. If a track does not have an ID3 tag, the song title or file name is displayed.

- [1] Current audio mode
- [2] Song title
- [3] Artist name
- [4] Album title (Folder name)
- [5] Play time
- [6] Progress bar
- [7] Total time
- [8] Album art (Displayed only when the device is connected via USB and the track contains artwork.)

To Play a Track

- 1 Connect the device you want to play from.

Bluetooth setting: ➔ P.81

Connecting your iPhone/iPod/USB device: ➔ P.94

- 2 Select the audio output device. ➔ P.71
- 3 Press **SOURCE** switch to select [USB], [iPod] or [Bluetooth].
- 4 Press **⏪** or **ENT** switch to display the playlist. ➔ P.98
- 5 Select the supported audio file you want to play. ➔ P.93
- 6 Press **⏪** or **ENT** switch to play a track.
