## **Periodic Checks**

You should also perform other periodic maintenance checks at least once a month regardless of how often you ride, or more often if you ride frequently.

Also, check the odometer reading against the Maintenance Schedule and perform all maintenance that is due. ▶ P. 37

| Tires and wheels | Check the air pressure (⊇ P. 48), examine tread for wear and damage (⊇ P. 49, 49), and check the wheels for damage.          |
|------------------|--|
| Fluid levels     | Check the engine oil level (≥ P. 54), and brake fluid level (≥ P. 58).   |
| Lights           | Check that the headlight, position light, brake light, taillight, turn signals and license plate light are working properly. |
| Controls         | Check the freeplay of the clutch lever (►) P. 65), and throttle grip (►) P. 68).   |
| Drive chain      | Check the slack (⊇ P. 61), adjust the slack (⊇ P. 62), and lubricate (⊇ P. 47) as needed.                                    |
| Fuses            | Check that you have a full supply of spare fuses.  |
| Nuts & bolts     | Check the major nuts and bolts, and tighten as needed.   |
