
## If a Fuse Blows

## Main and Shift Motor Fuse Access

## UNDER SEAT



(1) fuse

- (4) main fuse holder assembly
- (2) fuse holder assembly
- (5) shift motor fuse holder assembly

- (3) fuse holder
- 1. To prevent an accidental short circuit, turn the ignition switch OFF (O) before checking or replacing the fuses.
- 2. To access the fuse (1), remove the seat (page 92).
- 3. Remove the fuse holder assembly (2).
- 4. Pull the old fuse out of the fuse holder (3).
- 5. Push the new fuse into the fuse holder.

If you do not have a replacement fuse with the proper rating for the circuit, install one with a lower rating.

## NOTICE

Replacing a fuse with one that has a higher rating greatly increases the chance of damage to the electrical system.

6. Install the fuse holder assembly and seat.
