

Load Limits & Guidelines

Load Limits

Following are the load limits for your ATV:

There are limits to how much weight can be carried on your ATV and be pulled in a trailer.

The following load limits apply to standard equipment only. Modifying your ATV, using non-standard equipment, or riding on terrain that is not flat and smooth could further reduce these limits.

maximum weight capacity **485 lb (220 kg)**

(includes the weight of the rider,
all cargo, and accessories.)

front cargo rack weight limit **= 66 lb (30 kg)**

rear cargo rack weight limit **= 133 lb (60 kg)**

tow weight limit **= 850 lb (385 kg)**

(Combined weight of the trailer
and all cargo in the trailer)

tongue weight **= 30 lb (14 kg) recommended**

(Weight on the trailer tongue)

tongue and rear cargo weight = **133 lb (60 kg) maximum**

(Combined weight on the
trailer tongue and on the rear
cargo rack)

Tongue weight can be measured with an ordinary bathroom scale. Place the scale under the tongue, using either a tongue jack or other support to keep the trailer level.

The weight of added accessories will reduce the maximum cargo weight you can carry.
