- 1. Pull the breather tube (2) out of the handlebar cover hole (3).
- 2. To open the fuel fill cap (1), turn it counterclockwise.
- 3. Add fuel until the level reaches the bottom of the filler neck (4). Avoid over filling the tank. There should be no fuel in the filler neck.

AWARNING

Gasoline is highly flammable and explosive. You can be burned or seriously injured when handling fuel.

- Stop the engine and keep heat, sparks and flame away.
- Handle fuel only outdoors.
- Wipe up spills immediately.
- 4. After refueling, turn the fuel fill cap clockwise until it clicks.
- 5. Insert the breather tube into the handlebar cover hole.

If you replace the fuel fill cap, use a Honda Genuine replacement part or equivalent.

NOTICE

Gasoline can damage the camouflage coating.

Do not allow spilled gasoline to pool on camouflage colored bodywork. Also, do not allow gasoline soaked rags to be placed on camouflage bodywork.
