

The engine guard (1) protects the engine crankcase.

The skid plate (2) protects the frame. Check the skid plate and engine guard for cracks, damage or looseness.

Tighten any loose fasteners. Replace the skid plate or engine guard as required.

The front boot guards (3) protect the rubber driveshaft boots. The front driveshaft gurads (4) protect front driveshaft.

Check the front boot guards and front driveshaft guards for cracks, damage or looseness.

Tighten any loose fasteners. Replace the front boot guards and front driveshaft guards as required.

Have the engine guard and skid plate replaced if they are cracked or damaged. If the guard and plate bolts are loose, tighten them securely.
