Periodic Checks

You should also perform other periodic maintenance checks at least once a month regardless of how often you ride, or more often if you ride frequently.

Also, check the odometer reading against the Maintenance Schedule and perform all maintenance that is due. ▶ P. 62

Tires and wheels	Check the air pressure (2 P. 73), examine tread for wear and damage
rifes and wrieers	(▶ P. 73), and check the wheels for damage.
Fluid levels	Check the engine oil level (♠ P. 81), engine coolant level (♠ P. 88), and brake fluid level (♠ P. 90).
Lights	Check that the headlight, position lights, brake light/taillight, turn
Controls	signals, and license plate light are working properly.
	Check the freeplay of the throttle grip (≥ P. 96), the clutch lever
	(VFR1200X/XA) (→ P. 99). Check the front brake lever (→ P. 99), rear
	brake pedal, and parking brake (VFR1200XD/XDA) (→ P. 92) operate
	properly.
Fuses	Check that you have a full supply of spare fuses.
Nuts & bolts	Check the major nuts and bolts, and tighten as needed.
