Starting the Engine (Continued)

6 Press the start button with the throttle completely closed.

- Do not open the throttle when starting the engine with the choke on. This will lean the mixture, resulting in hard starting.
- Immediately after the engine starts, push the choke lever forward to the halfway position.
- 8 About a half minute after the engine starts, push the choke lever forward all the way to fully off.
- 9 If idling is unstable, open the throttle slightly.

High Air Temperature 35°C (95°F) or Above:

 \bigcirc Do not use the choke.

- (2) With the throttle slightly open (less than 1/8
 - in), press the start button.

Low Air Temperature 10°C (50°F) or Below:

- Follow steps 1-6 under Normal Air Temperature.
- 2 Warm up the engine by opening and closing the throttle slightly.
- (3) Continue warming up the engine until it runs smoothly and responds to the throttle when the choke lever is at fully off.

If the engine does not start:

- Press the engine stop switch to the XX (Stop) position.
- Push the choke lever down all the way to fully off.
- 3 Open the throttle fully.
- 4 Press the start button for 5 seconds.
- (5) Wait 10 seconds, then press the engine stop switch to the \bigcap (Run) position.
- 6 Follow steps 1-2 under High Air Temperature.
