TROUBLESHOOTING

Brake lever soft or spongy

- 1. Air bubbles in hydraulic system.
- 2. Low fluid level.
- 3. Hydraulic system leaking.

Brake lever too hard

- 1. Sticking piston(s)
- 2. Clogged hydraulic system.
- 3. Pads glazed or worn excessively.

Brakes drag

- 1. Hydraulic system sticking.
- 2. Sticking piston(s)
- 3. Incorrect rear brake pedal adjustment.

Brakes grab or pull to one side

- 1. Pads contaminated.
- 2. One side of front brake faulty.
- 3. Disc or wheel misaligned.

Brake chatter or squeal

- 1. Pads contaminated.
- 2. Excessive disc runout.
- 3. Caliper installed incorrectly.
- 4. Disc or wheel misaligned.
